



BACCARAT

Baccarat, meaning zero or nothing, also known as “punto banco,” is a card game played between two hands, the Player and the Banker. The object of the game is to get a total of 9 or whoever gets the total closest to 9 wins.

Card Values:

1. Ace shall have a value of 1.
2. Any card from ace to 9 inclusive shall have its face value
3. Any 10, Jack, Queen, or King shall have a value of zero.
4. The point count of a hand shall be the right digit of the total value of both cards in a hand.

How to Play:

1. Patrons have the option to bet on either the Player or Banker’s hand and/or Tie.
2. There shall be two hands dealt, one of which shall be designated as the Player's hand and the other as the Banker's hand and whichever hand total is closest to 9 wins.
3. If the point count of either the Player or the Banker's hand after the initial four cards is 8 or 9, which is called a “natural,” no more cards shall be dealt to either hand and that hand automatically wins.
4. There are three outcomes for every game: Player wins, Banker wins, or Tie

Payout Odds:

Player	1:1
Banker (Non-Commission)	1:1
Banker (Commission)	less 5%
Tie 8:1	8:1
Pair	11:1
BSS-Pair	5:1
