



BLACKJACK

Blackjack is a casino game similarly known as Twenty-One. The object of the game is to win by achieving card totals higher than those of the Dealer's hand but not exceeding 21, or by stopping at a total in the hope that Dealer will bust.

Card Values:

1. An Ace will have a value of 11 except when a point total of 11 would give the Player or the Dealer a point total in excess of 21, in which case, it shall have a value of 1.
2. Any card from 2 to 10 inclusive shall have its face value.
3. Any Jack, Queen, or King shall have a value of 10.
4. A hand consisting of cards valued as 10 with an Ace constitutes the highest possible points and is called a Blackjack.

How to Play:

1. Patrons bet against the Dealer's cards total.
2. After the initial two cards, if the Dealer's card is not an Ace, the Player will be given a chance to surrender half of the wager; if the Dealer's card is an Ace, insurance will be offered.
3. During the course of the game, Players will be given the option to Stay, Draw, Split, or Double.
4. After the Players had their turn, Dealer draws their cards, stays on hard or soft 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, or busts if cards total go over 21 points.
